I joined AOSW in 2016 and have since participated in national conferences as presenter and attendee. I recently joined the AOSW Finance Committee.

I have worked at Moffitt Cancer Center, an NCI Designated Cancer Institute for the last 7.5 years. During this time, I participated in and held numerous leadership positions in our large social work department. One of the most impactful is my service on the Education Committee where I served as co-chair from March 2016 to July 2020. As a co-chair and founding member, I led the department's commitment to continuing education by the development and implementation of monthly educational opportunities. To increase staff competency, I played a major role in engineering "Skills Fest" a creative cross training initiative to ensure both inpatient and outpatient social workers have the necessary care coordination

skills to meet the needs of patients and families. I am truly proud of the growth the education committee has achieved and remain on as committee member. In addition to the Education Committee, I was elected to serve as a member and later co-chair of Moffitt's Social Work Advisory Council. The Council is an opportunity for front line staff and social work leadership to engage in active problem solving and department initiatives. There I had the opportunity to learn more about the policies and procedures as well as "big picture" goals for the organization. My leadership skills were further acknowledged by my promotion in April 2020 to Supervisor for Outpatient Social Work. I currently act as direct supervisor for social work staff located at satellite locations and provide weekly clinical supervision for those working towards licensure.
