Study for adults with cancer

The Cancer Support Community (CSC) is seeking cancer patients/survivors 18 years or older who identify as Black and African American to participate in a focus group to share their thoughts and experiences on clinical trials and clinical trial enrollment in their community.

It has been estimated that fewer than 1 in 20 adult cancer patients enroll in cancer clinical trials and African Americans represent only 5% of clinical trial participants. This research will help develop an innovative and culturally appropriate peer clinical trials support program for Black/African American cancer patients.
