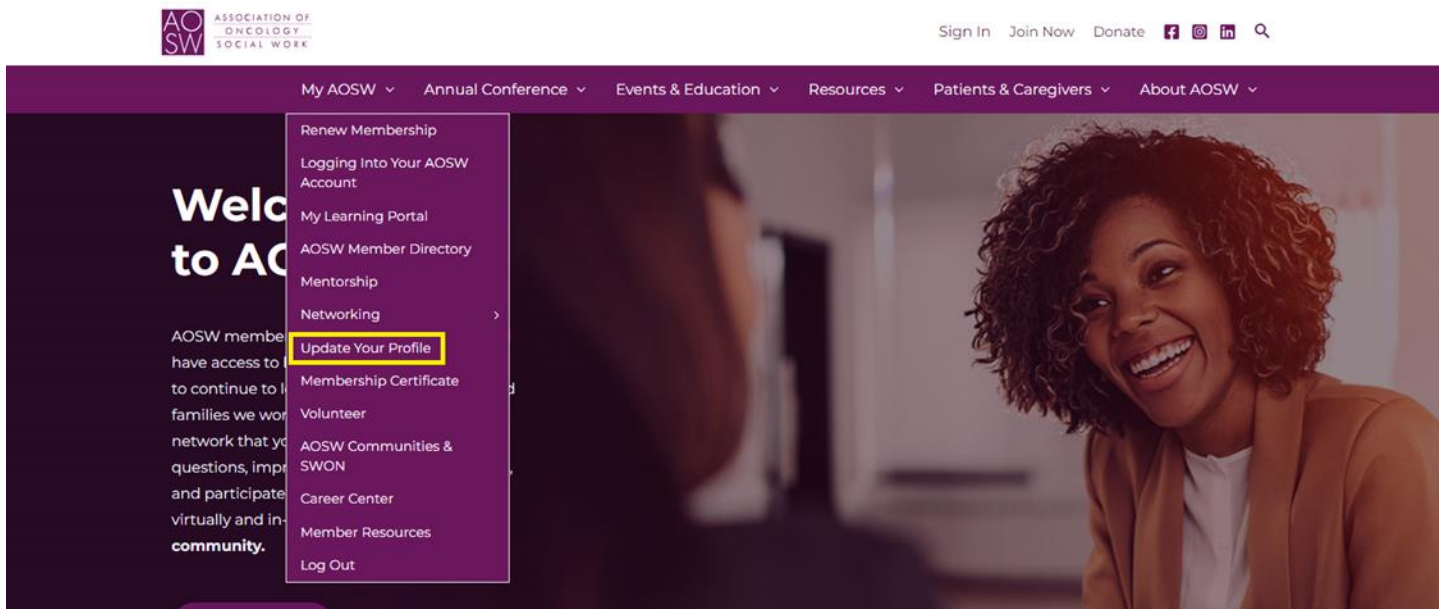


## How to Join a Special Interest Group (SIG)

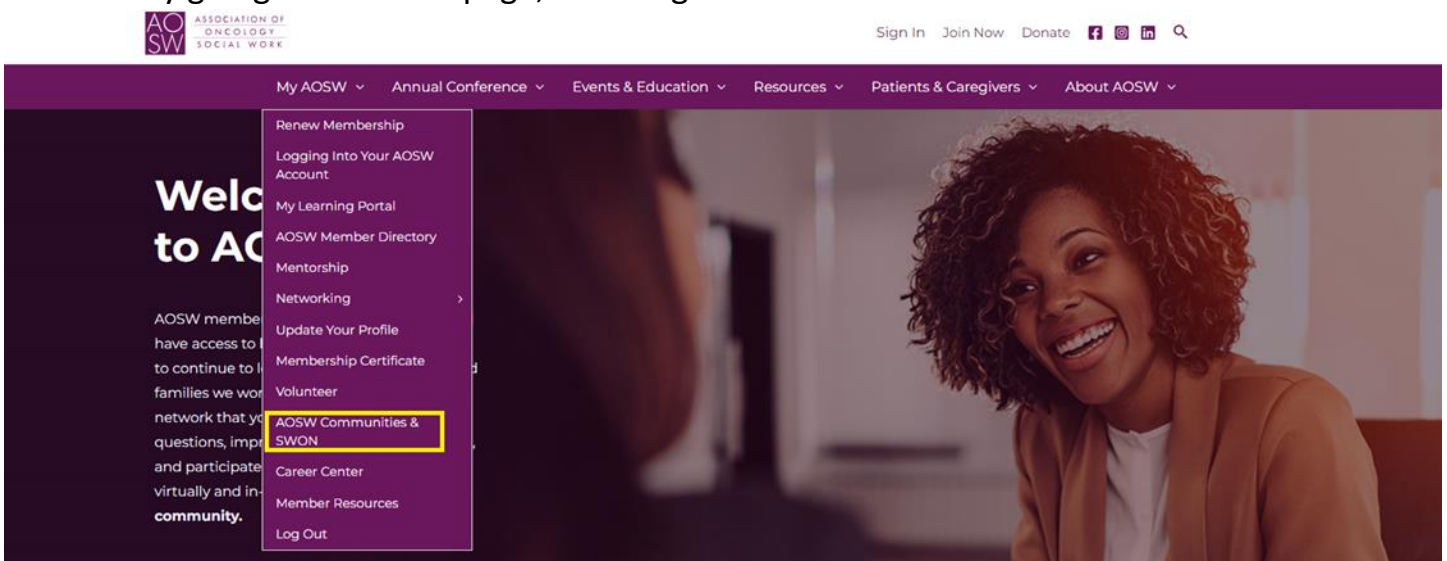
3. Scroll down to drop box for “Special Interest Group” and select the SIG group(s) you want to join,” then navigate to the bottom of the page and select “Next”

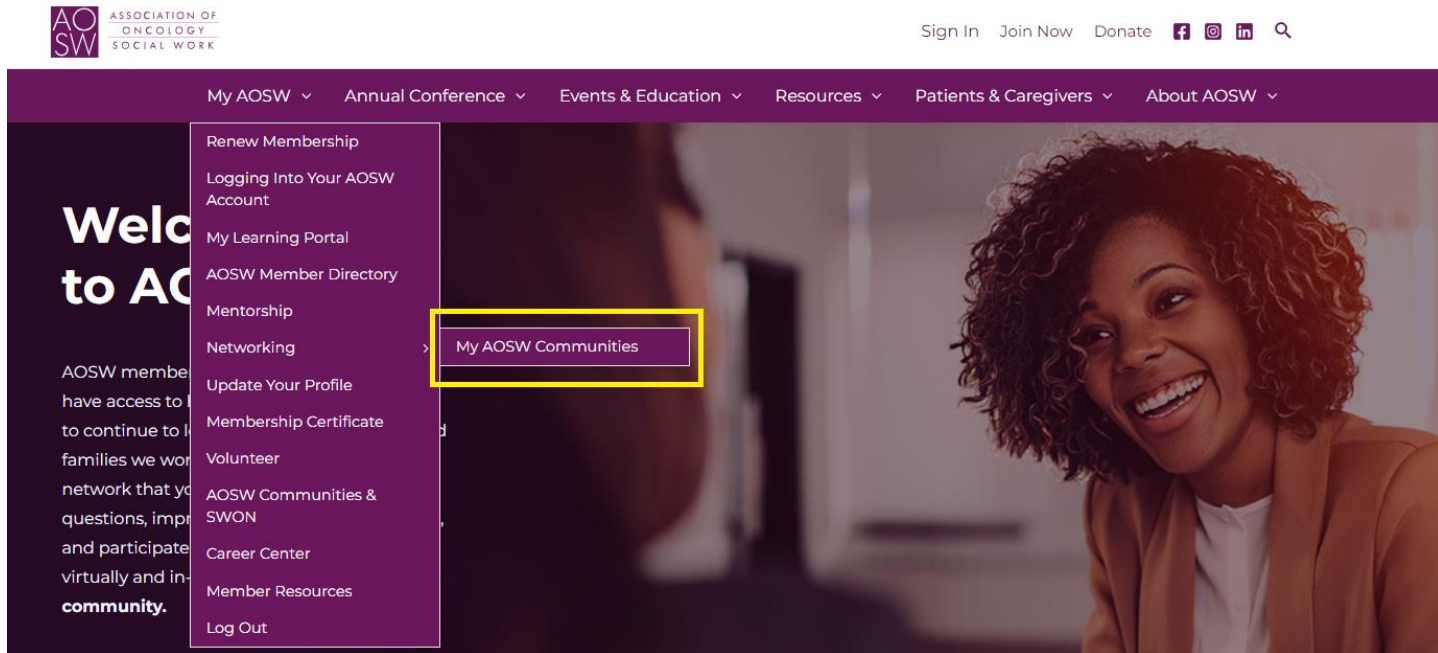
4. Make sure to scroll to the bottom of the last page and click on “Save Changes”

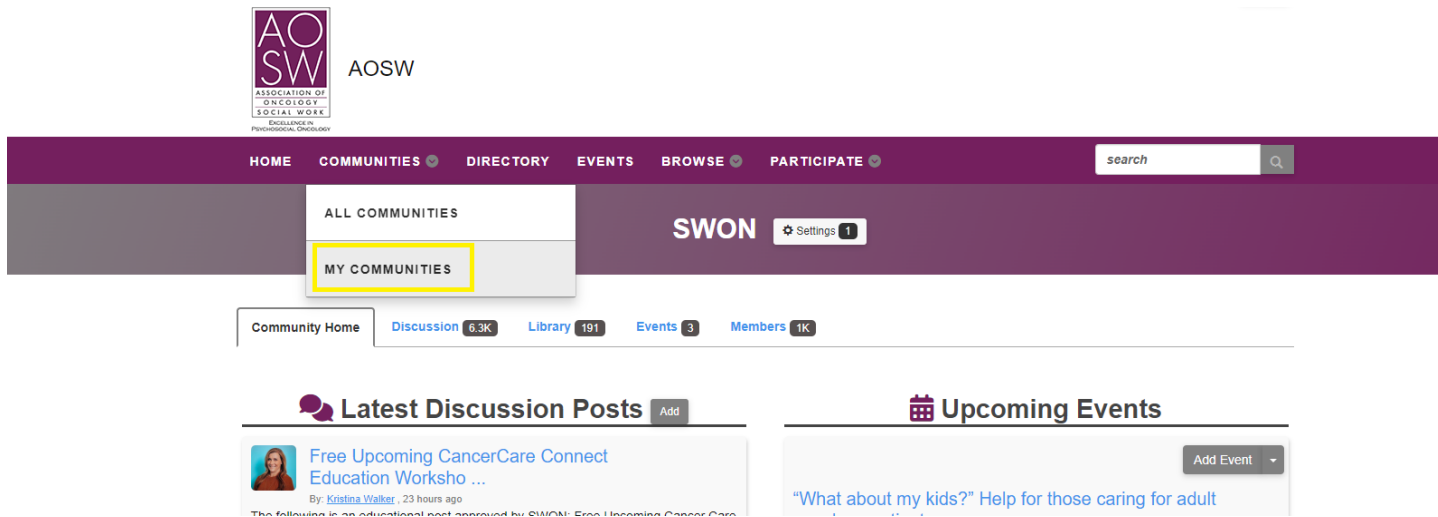
5. After you have done this, you could be able to see the SIG in “My Communities.” You can find that by going to the main page, selecting “AOSW Communities & SWON”
